• The surgery center will call you 2-3 days before surgery for registration. They will then call the day before surgery to let you know what time to arrive as well as any other pre op instructions. If your surgery is on a Monday, they will call you the Friday before. They will call between 3:30-5:30, if you have not received a call from them by 5:00pm you can call the number listed above. If you need to cancel or reschedule please call our office at the number listed below.

- Discontinue the following medications accordingly prior to surgery. You can take Tylenol for pain.
 - Coumadin/Warfarin
 - Xarelto/Paradaxa
 - Aspirin 7 days
 - Anti-inflammatories (Advil, Aleve, Ibuprofen, Naproxen, etc.)
 - Diclofenac, Meloxicam/Mobic 7 days
 - Plavix
 - 0
- You will need a driver to bring and take you home from surgery. Please bring a photo ID and your insurance cards with you the day of surgery.
- Some insurance companies require pre-authorization for surgical services. Pre-authorization doenot guarantee payment of services (insurance disclaimer). We will assist you by getting the surgical procedure pre-authorized. It is your responsibility to contact your insurance regarding your benefits, out of pocket expenses, and to insure the doctor and facility are in network.
